- Monthly expenses were \$1,770.79 and included \$359.79 of concession expenses and \$50 reimbursement to L. Dinunzio for the \$50 shortfall in payment last month for the 70 \$5 dunkin cards for fan appreciation night

President's Update:

- Spring sport update Working on raffles for Spartan Open \$340 from lacrosse, girls volleyball gave litchfield distillery basket, boys hockey \$160.
- Need a field hockey parent rep
